Installation

Plug one end of the included cable into the hard drive and the other end into a vacant USB port on your PC. Power for the hard drive is supplied by the USB cable.

After a few moments a window should appear and ask you what you'd like to do. Click on 'Open Folder'. A new window will open which will display the contents of the hard drive.

You'll need video playing software to view the video files. The media player that comes with Windows should suffice. The free VLC free and open source, cross-platform multimedia player and framework plays most multimedia files and various streaming protocols is also a great tool (https://www.videolan.org/vlc/index.html)

Viewing Files

Double click on the 'Course Videos' folder then double click on the video file. It should begin playing.

Each video is approximately one hour long. Some may be a bit shorter because something was edited out for any number of reasons.

A split screen will sometimes display between the course notes and the instructor. The course notes are included on the hard drive so that you can follow along. You will need Adobe Acrobat Reader installed in order to view the course notes. Each course note file covers the respective six-hour course day. Hence there are six video files for every one course notes file.
